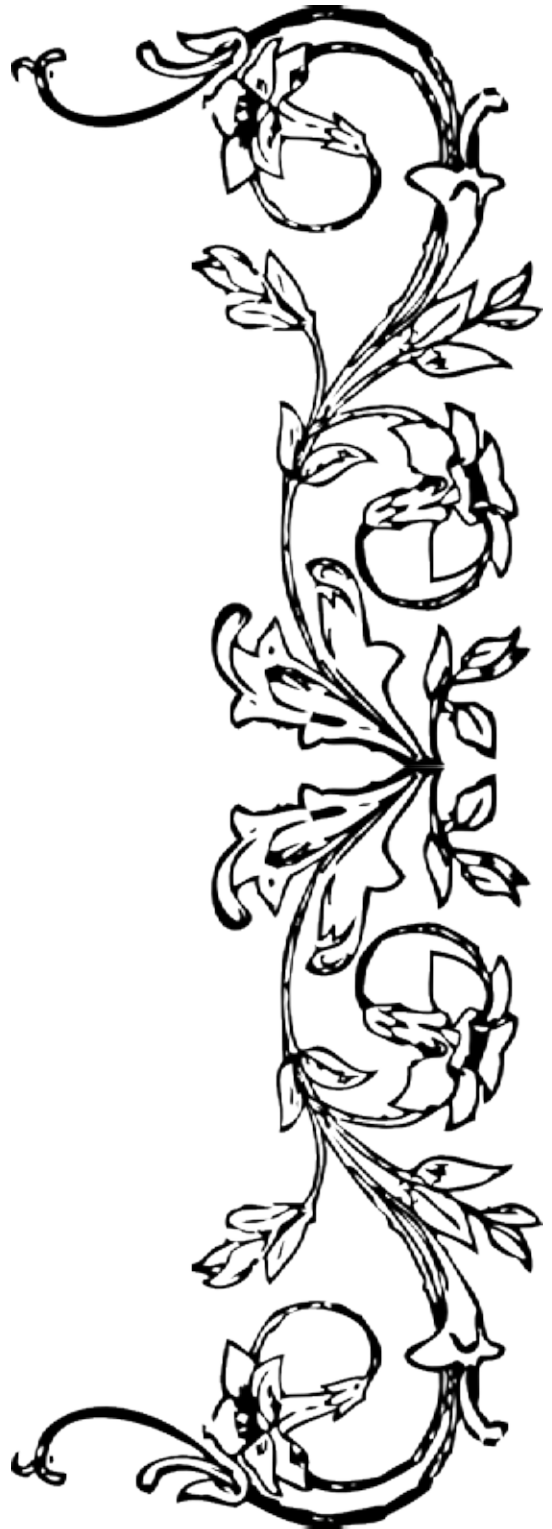

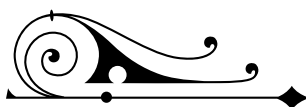

The Brewmiester Competition and accompanying activities will begin after evening court on Saturday, September 13th.

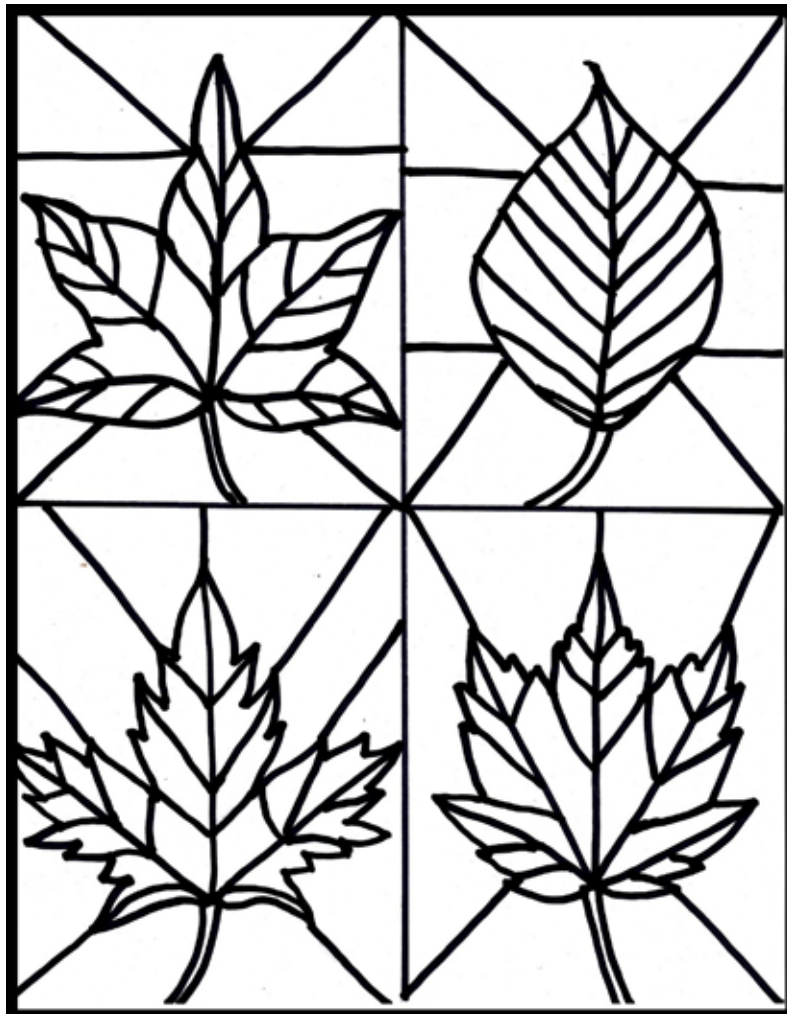

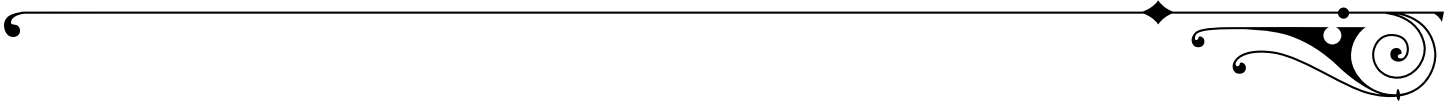
