


Greeting unto the Populace of the most ancient and glorious Barony of Loch Salann, here are the words of your Seneschal, Greetings.





What does it take to be a youth minister?

Legal adulthood - You're functioning as a mentor to minors, so the minimum age to hold this office is 18.

Current membership in the SCA – Required for all officers
Ability to pass a child safety background check – At this time the check is conducted by the kingdom, not the corporate headquarters; it's free to the applicant and your privacy is maintained.

Energy and reasonable physical health – A body in mobile condition is a must. Wide peripheral vision and at least average hearing helps. Ability to communicate clearly and calmly with children and adults – You'll be working closely with the Youth Combat marshals, parents, the seneschal, and adult volunteers as well as kids ranging in age from 5 to 17.

Basic budgeting skills – If you can anticipate costs, comparison shop, and submit requests and receipts in a timely manner, you're fine.

Basic writing skills – To submit simple monthly reports; I have forms for that.

A work/family schedule that allows you to attend barony-sponsored events - If you suddenly can't attend an event for which youth activities are planned, you'll need to arrange for a deputy to be there. Reliable transportation with some cargo capacity - Craft supplies, wasters & helmets, snack bags...youth activities require hauling stuff.

Ability to ask for help and delegate -

Volunteers are a must. The baron & baroness are highly supportive of youth activities, and so are many other officers. If you need help or materials, ask.

Ability to organize material, tasks, and bodies Like many tasks in the SCA. Courage to take responsibility and get necessary things done You'll have to function as The Voice of Authority at times. Can you distinguish between a child's scream of laughter and a scream of pain? Can you effectively end an argument between kids? Sometimes you just have to tell a child or parent No. Ability to multitask —

Can you keep one eye on the 5-year-old with that glue bottle while a 10-year-old needs your help to cut a foam shield at the same time a parent asks you a question?

Creativity tempered with pragmatism -

Can you construct imaginative games and crafts that maintain a reasonable degree of physical safety, don't cost a fortune, and, just maybe, relate to the Middle Ages?

Ability to take pleasure in the small moments – Like when one of "your" kids is recognized for his art or service to the barony. Or when that 5-year-old who spilled the glue asks if she can wear your token on the boffer battlefield.

If you've enjoyed yourself and helped out at three or four events, you probably have most of these skills already.

SCA kids overall have better manners than "mainstream" kids. They demonstrate longer attention spans and higher reasoning skills. They like carrying out adult tasks - setting up, cleaning up, water bearing. And SCA kids just love pretending and playing and getting silly alongside adults.

Youth Ministry does NOT require a degree in teaching or child psychology. You don't even need to be a parent. Come to me with your questions and ideas.

Directions:

From I-15, exit at 12th Street Exit (#347) in North Ogden. From the exit travel west onto 12th Street/Hwy 39 and travel to the top of Ogden Canyon at the Pineview Reservoir Spillway. Turn left on Hwy 158 and cross the reservoir, following the brown recreation signs to Wolf Creek and Powder Mountain. Veer to the left at the fork, staying on Hwy 158. You will come to a stop sign. Turn left onto Hwy 162; drive north for about 3 miles. Turn left on 4100 North; immediately take the first right onto 3300 East (signs point to "North Fork" and "Avon"). In 1.8 miles there is a "Y", turn left on the North Fork Road. About 3 miles later there will be a sign for the "Cuttler Flats Entrance" on your left (look for the SCA signs) and turn left here. The road turns to groomed dirt and winds for less than a mile. At the "T" turn right and follow the road till it opens up into a field, we are in the "Middle Bowery."
