


Greeting unto the Populace of the most ancient and glorious Barony of Loch Salann, here are the words of your Seneschal, Greetings,

Our quest instructors in scribal arts, Master RanthulfR, and archery, Earl Mika Longbow, added even more to the already vast store of information available to the populace through our members. All of the classes were full, some to overflowing, with students from all four of the sponsoring groups, the Barony of Gryphon's Lair, the Province of Arrow's Flight, the Shire of Cote du Ciel, and our own Barony of Loch Salann. Those in attendance were honored by the presence of His Majesty Daman and Their Royal Highness' Timmur and Saige. In addition to the classes a wonderful luncheon was available throughout the day. Barony of Loch Salann (Site is in Provo, UT) June 5-6, 2010

The Ramp of Despair is giggling at you! The Staircase of Doom is giving you the finger behind your back! Come help us celebrate a Quarter-Century (plus three) of Loch Salann Melec Madnesses on June 5th & 6th 2010, at its Incredibly ancient and honorable site at the castle in back of the Utah State Hospital in Provo, Utah. Opening announcements are tentatively planned for 10:00 am on Sat. (or whenever the event steward thinks that enough flahters have shown up.) Should we gather a sufficient number of flahters (42 seems to be the madic number), we will repeat last year's successful full-on castle slede scenario!! This year there will be an Arts & Sciences Melee Competition, sponsored by Lady Zafirah. regulring the efforts of two or more artisans on each piece entered; contact her for further details (zemlar@ahoo.com). On Sunday morning, weather allowing, there will be the traditional pas d'armes, hosted by House Catwing and open to all fighters; see the event steward for details, and bring your nicest banners and fighting clothes. If you' ve ever wanted to run/sponsor an activity/contest or teach a class (fighting or nonfighting), this is the place to do it; just clear it with the event steward and appropriate coordinator. While the site will officially OPEN by 8:00 am on Saturday, and CLOSE at 10:00 pm on Sunday, we may be allowed to set up tents friday night after 5:30 pm; please contact the event steward beforehand. Even though this will be a 2-day activity, participants are encouraged to come early on Sat., and bring picnic lunches and sunshades/tents (although there are numerous shade trees).





This is a dry site! Because this is a state facility, anyone bringing alcoholic beverages onsite or found to be in an incbriated condition must be politely asked to leave immediately! Off-site merchants are only 4-6 minutes away, and while ground fires are not permitted, off-the-ground firepits, hibachis and gas grills are. Pets are welcome if accompanied by responsible owners.

The SITE Fce is \$8 for adults (16 yrs. old and older), \$4 for youths, 5 yrs. old and younger are free and pregnant ladies get a \$2 rebate; per family price cap of \$24 (not per household!) Make checks payable to "Barony of Loch Salann, SCA Inc." DIRECTIONS: Take I-15 to the Provo Center Street exit 267; drive east on Center St. (about 2 miles) and enter the hospital grounds. Continue east and turn left at the large planter in the road; follow the road around and up to the castle area (the "off limits" signs aren't meant for us).


