


times and projects are being discussed right now, so go log on!

In the early years of the Barony, before it even was a barony, many great and wonderful articles were printed in the pages of The Questing Quill. We, the Chroniclers, thought that to seek out these past articles for reprinting, would not only be enjoyable for the populace, but also could be most helpful to those who have recently joined our game. And so, from time to time, over the next few months, please enjoy the wisdom and fun that has come from our most experienced members.

from the hearth .... An apple beverage associated with Autumn and Winter is Lambswool. Originally spelled La Mas Ushal, it came to us via the Druids. LAMBSWOOL 2 gal. mulled ale 2 eggs 5 apples a stones weight of honey (keep tasting) 5 pinches bf nutmeg (keep tasting) a handful of browned toast Pour ale in a large bowl and beat in the eggs. Add nutmeg and let set overnight, covered with a tea towel, in a cool place. Dice the apples (do not core). Put into a saucepan and cover, and cook at low heat till soft (it wouldn't hurt to add a little water from time to time). Keep the apples in cool dry place overnight. Next morning, mix honey and apples and let set for a few hours, stirring occasionally. Add mixture to mulled ale mixture, pouring back and forth till well mixed. Serve heated with browned toast floating on top. On Nov. 5, 1604 Guy Fawkes tried to blow up King James I of England together with his Parliament. This was known as the Gunpowder Plat and it was unsuccessful. A traditional cake is the rich spicy Parkin cake. It is sometimes called a Thor cake, pointing to a possible Saxon origin. In some parts of England, November 5 is referred to as Parkin Day. PARKIN CAKE 1/2 cup butter 2/3 cup rolled oats 1 cup all purpose flour. 1 Tbsp. sugar 1/2 tsp. ginger 1/4 tsp. cloves 1/2 tsp. salt 1/2 tsp. baking powder (1 tsp. grated lemon rind) 1/3 cup milk preheat oven to 350 degrees Treacle is a light molasses, you can use that or half honey and half molasses. The lemon rind is optional. Yelt butter and treacle together over a low heat. Combine the dry ingredients, mixing well. Add the butter mixture, alter-nately with the milk, to the dry ingredients, combining until everything is just moist. The batter will be a bit thin. Bake for 30 to 35 minutes in a greased pan. (May want to line with waxed paper. It does tend to stick.)
