






ARTEMISIA

Artemisia, Kingdom of. Transfer of branch name Montforet to the Kingdom of An Tir.

Celestine of Arn Hold. Name (see RETURNS for device).

Cicilia Deldanza. Device. Gules, a bend sinister argent between a sun in his splendor and an increscent moon Or, a bordure argent.

Dragonmarch, Shire of. Branch name (see RETURNS for device).

Eleanor the Silent. Name.

Gunnv{o,}r Vikarsd{o}ttir. Name.

Submitted as Gunnv{o,}r Vikarsdottir, we have added an accent to the byname to conform to period spelling practices.

Hauk Maclean. Name and device. Per bend sable and Or, a Latin cross fleury and a heart, a bordure counterchanged.

Iduna Snorrisdottir. Badge. (Fieldless) On a wagon wheel proper, an open scroll argent.

Inga Eriksdottir. Name and device. Sable, two scarpes argent each charged with a sprig of wolfsbane throughout purpure slipped and leaved vert.

Jofreyr Maurisson. Device. Per chevron sable and azure, a chevron between two bearded axes in saltire and a tree blasted and couped argent.

Jonet MacTeir. Name.

Lance Galloway. Name.

Madoc Kynith. Name (see RETURNS for device).

Mairsile Kendrick. Name.

Marcus Caecilius Existimator. Name (see RETURNS for device).

Montforet, Barony of. Release of device. Per chevron Or and argent, a chevron rayonny on the upper edge, in base a laurel wreath vert.

Muirgheal inghean Shitheach. Name and device. Argent, a thistle proper and on a chief wavy purpure two whelks fesswise reversed argent.

Submitted as Muirgheal nic Sitheach, the byname mixed Gaelic and Anglicized spellings. We would therefore have changed the anglicized nic to either inghean mhic or inghean u(i'). However, the submitter was under the impression that the byname means "daughter of Sitheach". This impression is mistaken: nic and the underlying Gaelic forms mean "descendant of", not "daughter of". We have changed the particle to match the intended meaning, and lenited the patronymic to make it grammatically correct.

Please instruct the submitter to draw the leaves of the thistle in proper heraldic style.

Niall Logan. Name and device. Per chevron dovetailed vert and Or, two bees respectant and a pine cone stem to chief proper.

Nicolette Deschamps. Name and device. Or, a butterfly purpure and a bordure wavy vert.

Nikolai Ivanovich Sudovshchikov. Name and device. Sable, a bear's head couped and on a chief Or three bear's paw prints gules.

Odor O'Dorney. Name and device. Or, two dragons combattant and an ermine spot gules.

Odor O'Dorney. Badge. (Fieldless) An ermine spot gules.

Phelim O'Neill. Name.

Pierre Xavier. Name.

Robert Blade. Name and device. Argent, a scimitar gules and a scimitar sable crossed in saltire.

Ronan of Hereford. Alternate name Ralph Bigod of Hereford.



From the Cook's Corner

On the evening of March 6, 2001, members of the Baronial Cook's Guild met at the home of His Lordship Vogg to prepared and partake of a lovely meal. This meal was under the direction of Master Edward and Mistress Margaret.

The meal consisted of a Hearty Vegetable Soup, Roast Chicken with a Honey & Soy Sauce Glaze, Brown Rice, and Apple Pie for dessert. The Mendeith's were assisted in the food preparation by Mistress Casamira, Lordships Vogg and James, and by Lady Rhiannon.

As the dishes were quite simple it gave us plenty of time for conversation and puns. After eating our fill (and then some) we decided on the following recipe to share.

Hearty Vegetable Soup

- 2 large carrots, peeled and sliced
- 1/3 cup olive oil
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 2 celery stalks, chopped
- 1 quart water or stock
- 1 small bunch parsley, chopped
- 2 large turnips, peeled and cut into small cubes
- 2 ounces dried short macaroni or any medium sized pasta shape
- 4 outside leaves of green cabbage
- Salt and pepper

You will need a large saucepan. Dice the carrots if they are really large. Warm the olive oil in the saucepan, and then add the carrots, onions, and celery. Leave them to stew gently. Add the water or stock and sprinkle in the parsley. Simmer for 10 minutes. Put in the cubed turnips. Simmer for 10 minutes longer. Add the pasta. Simmer for another 10 minutes, until the vegetables are soft and pasta is well cooked. Taste and adjust the seasoning. Mash in a few of the vegetables to thicken the liquid before you serve it. This soup should be thick enough for a spoon to stand up in it. If desired serve sprinkled with grated cheese.

The Cook's Guild welcomes anyone who wishes to attend. Our next meeting is scheduled for April 3, 2001. It will be under the direction of Mistress Casamira and Lordship Vogg. Tanglwyst de Holloway. Alternate name Catriona Moriarty (see RETURNS for badge). Tristan Herv{e}. Name and device. Azure, two roses slipped and leaved in saltire, a chief embattled and a point pointed ploy{e} Or.
Wolfram von N{u:}rnberg. Name (see RETURNS for device).
Ygraine Marschal. Name and device. Azure, a unicorn passant and chief embattled Or.

THE FOLLOWING HAVE BEEN RETURNED FOR FURTHER WORK

ARTEMISIA

Celestine of Arn Hold. Device. Per saltire purpure and vert, a swan rousant contourny argent. Conflict with Margarete Rau, registered November 2000, Per saltire purpure and vert, a swan rousant contourny wings displayed argent. There is only a single CD for the position of the wings (displayed vs. addorsed).

Dragonmarch, Shire of. Device. Quarterly sable and argent, a dragon passant Or impaled on a sword inverted bendwise proper all within a laurel wreath Or.
The petition did not include a description or picture of the proposed arms. In addition, we are concerned about the identifiability of the sword, as it is almost completely covered by the dragon.

Madoc Kynith. Device. Argent, a goutte de sang within a vol throughout sable.
While technically clear, this is in visual conflict with Hrolfr Lombungr, Argent, a pair of batwings conjoined sable, in chief a goutte de sang. While the goutte is a primary charge in the current device and a secondary charge in the conflict, the visual similarity is overwhelming.

Marcus Caecilius Existimator. Device. Gules, a pale wreathed argent and azure winged Or.
No evidence has been presented, nor was any found, that ordinaries can be winged. We could not reblazon this as a vol with a pale overall, as the wings clearly originate at the edge of the pale.

Tanglwyst de Holloway. Badge for Catriona Moriarty. Sable, a mullet of six points and a bordure argent.
There are several conflicts, including Anna Tuomaantyt{a:}r von Urwald, Sable, a mullet and a base wavy argent, and the badge for Jayme O'Darcy of Glen Laurie, Sable, on a mullet throughout argent a cat's paw print sable, within a bordure argent. Against Anna, there is a CD for changing the base to a bordure, but nothing for the difference between a mullet of six points and a mullet of five points. Against Jayme, there is a CD for removing the tertiary charge, but again no difference between a mullet of five points to a mullet of six points nor between a mullet and a mullet throughout.

Wolfram von N{u:}rnberg. Device. Or semy of wolf's paw prints, a wolf rampant azure sustaining a staff topped with a cross formy sable. The wolf's paw prints are so small as to be unrecognizable. Therefore, we are returning this for a redraw.
