

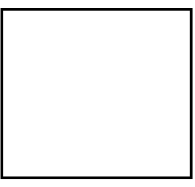
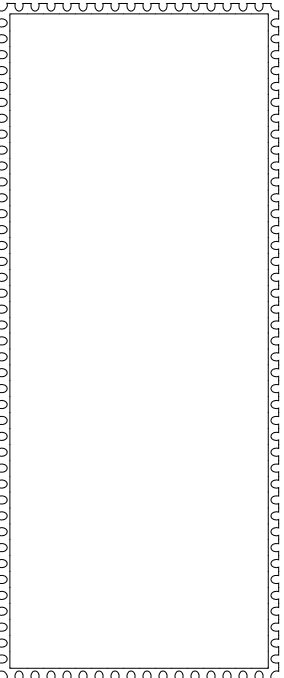

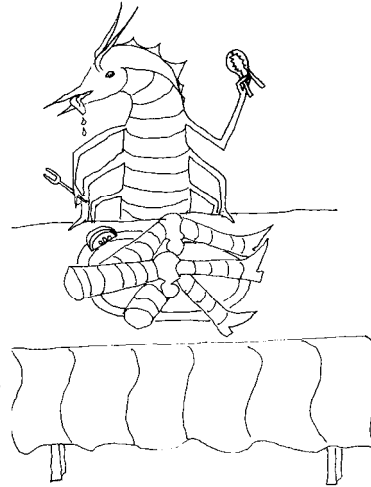

The events for the day will include Their Majesties Konrad and Kortland's final court, the Coronation of Reinmar and Albreda, the King's Champion Tournament, the Queen's Champion Tournament, and the Kingdom Rapier Champion Tournament. These inspiring displays of prowess will be spread throughout the day so that all may view the glory that is Artemisia.

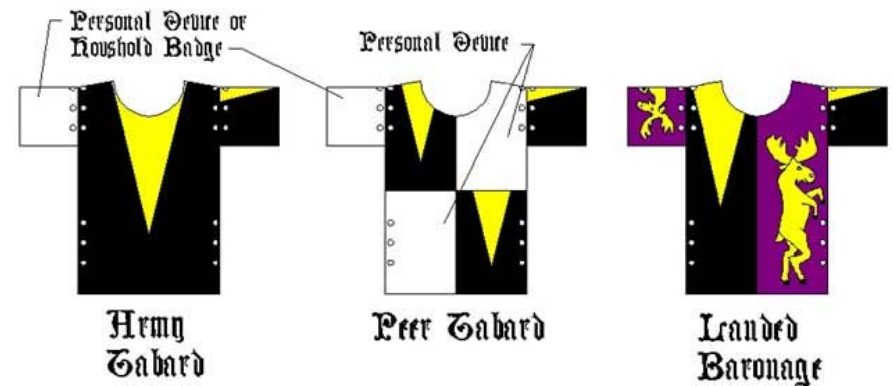
"Let it be known that as the summer campaign season is upon us, work is under way to build the might of Our armies, and thereby insure the safety of Our lands. An Artemisian Army Manual is currently under development and will be unveiled at this year's Raptor War. It is our sincere wish that upon its final completion, the Artemisian Army Manual shall be distributed to all corners of these lands so all fighters might become familiar with its teachings.

"The intent of the manual is to allow members of organized households and non-associated fighters alike to operate together by utilizing a common pool of commands and organizational formations. By establishing a basic level of understanding and training, it is the hope that any single fighter could join an Artemisian unit and operate effectively within the group.

"In addition to the Artemisian War Manual, specifications for the Artemisian Army Tabards have been posted on the Kingdom web site. The purpose of the tabards is to provide easy recognition of friends and foes upon the field. We hope that all gentles who fight under the Griffin's banner will be adorned in an Army tabard appropriate to their station.

"We would like to thank Sir Conrad von Zuberbuhler, the General of the Artemisian Army, and Sir Dahoud Samyuel, the Dean of the Artemisian War College, for their assistance in this grand endeavor."

We hope you enjoy the following recipe as much as we did.

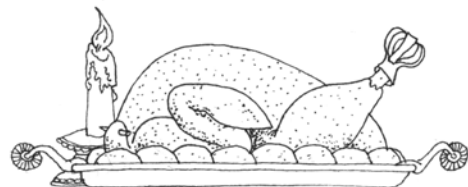
### Beef Slices With Rosemary

3 Tablespoons olive oil	Salt and Pepper, to taste
2 cloves garlic, chopped	1 Tablespoon chopped fresh rosemary
1 pound lean roast beef sliced quite thin	1/4 cup dry white wine

Heat a large heavy frying pan and add the oil and the garlic. Pan fry the meat slices on both sides quickly over medium high heat. salt and pepper the slices and remove them to a heated serving platter. Add the rosemary to the pan along with the white wine. Deglaze the pan (Use the wine to remove all the flavor from the pan) and pour the sauce over the meat to serve. Serves 6
