The time for Coronation has come upon us again. Their Royal Highnesses have chosen to honor the Barony of Loch Salann with this auspicious occasion. We are glad to welcome the Known World to our ancient and august Barony for such a grand celebration.

The events for the day will include Their Majesties Konrad and Kortland's final court, the Coronation of Reinmar and Albreda, the King's Champion Tournament, the Queen's Champion Tournament, and the Kingdom Rapier Champion Tournament. These inspiring displays of prowess will be spread throughout the day so that all may view the glory that is Artemisia.

The site for Coronation is the Downtown Holiday Inn in Salt Lake City. It is located at 999 South Main Street. The Holiday Inn can be reached at (801) 359-8600.

A block of rooms has been reserved under the name of The Society for Creative Anachronism. The rate for rooms in our block is \$69/night. The cut off date for reservations is February 8. 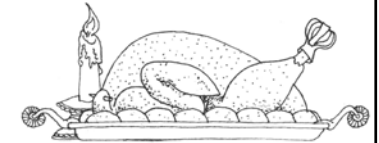
Directions:

From the Cook's Corner



Although there was no Cook's Guild meeting held in February, due to the War. I thought I'd dig in the archives and find a recipe or two to share. After all, we can't have anyone starving to death, while we are on hiatus. Please feel free to join us at our next meeting on March 5, 2002.

Pechonaya Ryba S Khrenom
(Baked Fish With Horseradish)

8 fish fillets (flounder or halibut)	1/2 teaspoon thyme
(about 2 pounds)	1/2 cup prepared horseradish
1/2 teaspoon salt	2 Tablespoons butter
Black pepper, to taste	1/2 cup sour cream

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Grease an oven-proof dish. Season the fish fillets with the salt, pepper, and thyme. Place four of the fillets in the baking dish. Spread half of the horseradish over them. Dot with half of the butter. Spread on half of the sour cream. Place the remaining four fillets on top and repeat the procedure, spreading on the remaining horseradish, butter and sour cream. Cover the dish and bake for 30 minutes. Remove the cover and continue baking for 15 minutes more, or until the fish is flaky. Makes 4 generous servings.

Apple Fritters

1 1/4 cup ale or beer	1/2 teaspoon salt
1 tablespoon dry yeast	Oil or shortening, for frying
1 cup flour	1 egg (optional)
3 to 4 apples (Macintosh etc.)	Sugar

Heat the beer to lukewarm. Put the yeast in a medium sized bowl and 1/4 cup of the beer. Stir and let sit about 10 minutes. Mix in the flour, egg (if used), salt, and remaining beer. Beat the mixture, then cover the bowl and leave in a warm place for about 1 hour. It should at least double in bulk. Peel the apples, core them and cut into wedges. Put apple slices in the bowl of batter and stir to coat apples well. Fry quickly in the oil, or deep fat until brown. Drain the browned fritters on paper towel as you remove them from the pan. When all have been cooked, sprinkly with sugar and serve.
