

Whipping Winds XVI

Thursday, August 15, 2019

Word comes from the North: The Kingdom of Avacal prepares once again to journey to our northern borders for Whipping Winds XVI. The call goes out to all Artemisia to muster at Whipping Winds to meet and greet our cousins from Avacal, hosted by the Barony of Sentinels' Keep and the Shire of Stan Wyrm.

Fighting, Archery, Thrown Weapons, Dancing and Music, Arts and Classes, and Shopping! All are to be found in abundant supply amongst the trees along the shore of the Marias River. Before we batten down the hatches for the long nights of winter, the Kingdoms of Artemisia and Avacal shall join together on the fields of battle, and around the campfires beneath the stars, to solidify our mutual respect and kinship.

Championships will be awarded for the Whipping Winds Archery and Thrown Weapons Tournaments. Sir Terrell will be hosting his 3rd Annual Booty Prize Tournament for Armored Combatants. There will be Armored and Rapier fighting and tournaments, both Friday and Saturday. We will have two and a half days of classes and youth activities, and a Baroness' Tea/Artisans Display. Both Friday and Saturday nights, we will be hosting Haflas and Games for all to enjoy and socialize. We are planning to hold a Silent Auction to benefit the Kingdom of Artemisia's General Fund – the main piece will be a custom-designed Inter-Kingdom Banner -Artemisia/Avacal.

Parents are asked to keep a mindful eye on their children. There are shade trees, an area for RV's, a permanent playground, and a permanent building with toilets & fresh water. Fire restrictions will be dependent on seasonal USFS restrictions, and will be posted at Gate.

Stay to the left and follow the road all the way back until you see the campground. Signs will be posted to guide travelers. If you cross the river, you have gone too far. The SCA Harassment and Bullying Policy



The SCA Harassment and Bullying Policy

From the Society Seneschals Handbook:

XXIV. SOCIETY SENESCHAL POLICIES & INTERPRETATIONS

4. Harassment and Bullying

The SCA prohibits harassment and bullying of all individuals and groups.

Harassment and bullying includes, but is not limited to the following:

offensive or lewd verbal comments directed to an individual;

the display of explicit images (drawn or photographic) depicting an individual in an inappropriate manner;

photographing or recording individuals inappropriately to abuse or harass the individual;

inappropriate physical contact; unwelcome sexual attention; or retaliation for reporting harassment and/or bullying.

Participants violating these rules are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual feels subjected to harassment, bullying or retaliation, they should contact a seneschal, President of the SCA, or the Kingdom's Board Ombudsman. If a participant of the SCA becomes aware that someone is being harassed or bullied, they have a responsibility pursuant to the SCA Code of Conduct to come forward and report this behavior to a seneschal, President of the SCA or Kingdom's Board Ombudsman.



The SCA Harassment and Bullying Policy



The following statement must be posted at gate/troll at every SCA event in a size large enough for people to see it as they enter our events. This language must likewise be quoted in ALL site handouts at every event a site where a handout is made available.

Interesting Facts About Salat (or Salad as We Know It)

Salads are a part of most people's diets. Here is a brief history of Salats (Salads as we know them).



"Salad, a term derived from the Latin "sal" (salt), which yielded the form salata, 'salted things' such as the raw vegetables eaten in classical times with a dressing of oil, vinegar or salt. The word turns up in Old French as salade and then in late 14th century English as salad or sallet." ---Oxford Companion to Food, Alan Davidson 2nd edition, 2006 (p. 682).

Although Quinoa has been dated back to early days of man (it's been found in the Andes Mountains of Bolivia, Chile, and Peru; Barley (from Ethiopia and Southwest Asia); other high protein grains that could have been used in the Middle Ages and Renaissance are: Polenta (polenta is made from ground yellow or white corn that has had the germ removed); Bulgur (bulgur is a grain often used in Middle Eastern

cuisine); Amaranth (one of the world's oldest grains, amaranth is a South American grain); Farro (Farro, also referred to as emmer, is a wheat grain that was one of the first domesticated crops in the Fertile Crescent thousands of years ago and was used in Egyptian bread making); Spelt (Spelt is an ancient grain that was commonly eaten in medieval times); Buckwheat (Buckwheat groats, also called kasha, are hulled grains from the buckwheat plant often found in Eastern Europe and Russia); Millet (Millet is a small, whole grain food that is a staple grain in many Asian and African countries; Kamut (a form of grain grown in many cultures and is believed to have first been grown in Egypt or Asia; and Teff (from the seed of an Ethiopia).

*I use a mixture of any of the following (whatever is available at my local market): Arugula***, Butterhead, Chicory***, Dandelion Greens***, Endive***, Escarole, Frisée, Kale, Lamb's Lettuce***, Mesclun, Radicchio, Romaine***, Spinach, Tat Soi, or Watercress***. Those with the trile asterisk (***) were definitely eaten before 1700 and possibly as early as the ancient Romans and Greeks so would be great for "eating your way through history".
