

Saturday, November 16, 2019



Lamb With Honey And Almonds

Salads are a part of most people's diets. Here is a brief history of Salats (Salads as we know them).



The basis of this dish comes from a recipe in a book that was published in the Middle Ages (I was in the Society For Creative Anachronism which is a group that re-creates the Middle Ages and was trying to "translate" the recipe from using non-standard measurement to what a modern cook would need usually). It is different from what we would normally eat (because of the spices) but it IS delicious!

Lamb With Honey And Almonds

Ingredients

Shoulder of Lamb (approximately 3 lbs.) or lamb chops

3 tbsp. olive oil

1 tsp salt

1 tsp. pepper

1 pinch saffron

1 tsp fresh grated ginger

½ tsp grated cinnamon

1 c. minced onion

1 tbsp. butter

2 c. water

2 oz. blanched almonds

1 tbsp olive oil

1 c. honey or agave nectar

½ tsp., nutmeg

Lamb With Honey And Almonds

Directions

- 1) Brown the lamb (if using the shoulder I suggest cutting the meat into cubes to allow faster cooking) in hot oil in a Dutch oven,
- 2) Add salt, pepper, saffron, ginger, cinnamon, onion, and butter and continue cooking over a medium heat until the onions are soft and lightly brown.
- 3) Add water to the lamb, cover, and simmer for about 1 ½ hours (until the lamb is tender).
- 4) In a separate pan saute the almonds in about 1 tbsp of olive oil over a low heat until they become golden brown then drain and set aside.
- 5) When the almonds are lightly brown remove the lamb to a serving platter and retain the liquid in the Dutch oven.
- 6) Pour the sauce and allow any fat to rise (I place it in the freezer for about 5 minutes which allows the fat to congeal but the rest won't if you limit it to that time period) and pour off all of about ½ c. of the sauce.
- 7) Add the almonds to the ½ c. of sauce and add in the honey (or agave nectar), nutmeg, and almonds and stir.
- 8) Pour sauce over the lamb and serve.
