

Fighting, archery, thrown weapons, relaxing in the sun - what more could you want? Come on out! Enjoy the day!

Opening announcements are tentatively planned for 10:00 am on Saturday (or whenever the event steward thinks enough fighters have shown up). The more fighters we have, the more fun the castle siege scenarios will be! While all this is going on, the competitions for Baronial archery and thrown weapons champions will also be taking place. So, prepare your gear, polish your weapons and armor, and rally to meet the melee challenge!

Please note, the annual pas d'armes, hosted by House Catwing & Hold Tyte, is moved to Baron's War to encourage more participants and gallery members to join the fun! Stay tuned as we will publish more details soon!

If you ever wanted to run/sponsor and activity or contest, or teach a class (fighting or non-fighting), this is the place to do it; just clear it with the event steward and appropriate coordinator.

The site will officially OPEN by 8:00 am and CLOSE at 10:00 pm on Saturday. We will be allowed to set up tents Friday night after 5:30 pm. As this is now a one-day event only, there will be no camping permitted. Participants are encouraged to come early on Saturday and bring picnic lunches and sunshades or tents (although there are numerous shade trees).

Also please note that there is HANDICAP ONLY parking at the castle amphitheater area. You may unload in that area only, then quickly move your vehicle either above to the parking area at the top or below by the hospital. All non-handicap vehicles must be parked elsewhere or will be towed!
