My two-year warrant as Baronial Seneschal ends this coming March. Now I must ask for another volunteer to step into the office.

The Seneschal works with the Exchequer, the Baron and Baroness, and the officers for specific activities to keep the business and administrative functions of the barony running smoothly. The tasks include heading monthly forum meetings, communicating with the Kingdom Seneschal and submitting monthly reports, evaluating and approving event bids, and supporting recruitment efforts.

No legal education or experience is required, just a strong desire to keep your home barony healthy through service. A reasonable ability to communicate in person and in writing, solve problems, and organize time and tasks helps a great deal. A personal computing device with a reliable internet connection is a must. The availability to attend most of the events sponsored by Loch Salann is highly encouraged.

If you would like to serve but would feel more comfortable easing into the responsibility, the seneschal always needs a deputy.

# Missive from our Exchequer

Greetings to the Populace of the Barony of Loch Salann, I am looking for one or two deputies to learn the job of Exchequer for the Barony. I will be stepping down as exchequer in June of 2026. Though two and a half years seems so far from the present I would like to have the time to thoroughly train my successor.

Office of Exchequer is the Chief Financial officer for the Barony and is responsible for the money and maintenance if all inventory. Duties include. A monthly report of the financial activity of the Barony to the Kingdom Exchequer as well as a quarterly report at the end of each calendar quarter and a Doomsday report at the end of the year. All these reports are filed electronically using provided excel workbooks and ledgers.

The Exchequer works with the Seneschal and the Baron and Baroness to submit an annual budget to the Kingdom Exchequer as well as decide financial policy.

An annual inventory of the Baronial Storage unit needs to be conducted. And finally the Exchequer works with the Seneschal, Baron/Baroness, and Event Steward to create an event budget, sits at gate to collect site fees, files post event reports and makes deposits to the bank.

An understanding of excel is helpful but not necessary. I'll teach you how to use the ledger. A basic understanding of household accounting is also helpful but if you can balance a checkbook (yes we use checkbooks still) you can do this job. Owining a scanner/printer is an important tool to have.

While anyone may come and display (and all are encouraged to do so) only a resident of the Northern region of Artemisia (Montana) is eligible to be named a Baronial Champion.


